| Growing Future Technical Leaders in Grey Bruce | Kinetic Knights Robotics -- Lana Spletstoeser, a Grade 12 student at Kincardine Secondary School, and a leader with the Kinetic Knights | This grant will help start a project for young people ages 9-14 in the Grey Bruce region. The Knights will invest in starting five new First Lego League teams for elementary school aged kids. With \$1,000 per team, they will be able to buy a EV3 lego mindstorm kit for \$400, software for \$120, a new laptop to run the software for approximately \$300, and a field set up kit which is about \$130.00. This will equip them to start a team and be ready to take part in competitions in 2016. | 5000 |
